## NOTICE TO OWNER/OCCUPANT/PUBLIC

### **SUBJECT: Imperial Highway Water Main Abandonment**

The City of Downey awarded work to George Pounder (Contractor) for the abandonment of an aging, leaking water main crossing Imperial Hwy. between Lakewood Blvd. and Rose Ave.. The water work was recently completed but the replacement and restoration of affected concrete street, curb, gutter, and sidewalk remain. The abandonment of this water main was necessary to ensure the efficient delivery of drinking water to our customers, and fire protection for this area.

The removal and replacement of affected concrete sidewalk, curb, gutter, and small portion of street on both the north and south sides of Imperial Hwy. are scheduled to be completed between the hours of 6 a.m. Tuesday, November 29, 2011 and 6 a.m. Wednesday, November 30, 2011 assuming favorable weather conditions. All streets will remain open to through traffic during this construction effort but may be impacted somewhat due to the traffic control set up to conduct the work. The outer-most (number three) lane going easterly on Imperial Hwy. will be shut down to traffic during the above noted hours at the end of which the traffic control will be removed and vehicles allowed to resume travel along this lane.

The nature of this work does involve construction equipment so please be advised that there will be some noise associated with conducting this work. Vehicles and pedestrians will be safely routed around construction areas in order maintain through traffic. The Contractor will also coordinate with adjacent property owners to ensure access to properties throughout the course of the work.
