NOTICE TO OWNER / OCCUPANT

SUBJECT: Firestone Boulevard Water Service Abandonment

In anticipation of planned street rehabilitation along Firestone Boulevard over the next several years, the City of Downey Utilities Division is abandoning an aging water service line crossing Firestone Blvd. between the entrance to Stonewood Center and Lakewood Blvd. Work is scheduled to be completed between 11 p.m. Tuesday, March 27, 2012 and 3 p.m. Wednesday, March 28, 2012 assuming favorable weather conditions.

The water improvements involve isolating and dewatering an existing 8-inch water main on the north side of Firestone Blvd. so that the aging service line can be removed and abandoned from the main. Westbound travel lanes on Firestone Blvd. in this area will be reduced from three to two but will remain open to through traffic during the time and dates noted above.

Water services for properties along Firestone Blvd. within the limits of work will be temporarily turned off during early morning hours on Wednesday March 28 from approximately 2 a.m. to 6 a.m. while abandonment of the water service is completed. The City will coordinate closely with affected parties prior to shutdown of water service to help minimize any inconveniences associated with this work. The nature of this work does involve construction equipment so please be advised that there will be some noise associated with conducting the work.
