SMOKE AND CARBON MONOXIDE ALARM ACKNOWLEDGMENT

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I am the owner and occupant of the below referenced property. I further certify that Smoke alarms and Carbon Monoxide alarms are present and functioning in ALL the following locations as noted below*.

You must check ALL following boxes:

- Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Alarms: On the ceiling or wall outside of each separate sleeping area in the immediate vicinity of bedrooms or in each hallway outside of the rooms.
- Smoke Alarms: In each room used for sleeping purposes.
- Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Alarms: In each story, including any habitable basement. (Note: In dwellings or dwelling units with split levels and without an intervening door between the adjacent levels, smoke and carbon dioxide alarms installed on the upper level shall suffice for the adjacent lower level provided that the lower level is less than one full story below the upper level.)

**Retrofitted Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Alarms may be battery operated*

CODE SECTION: California Residential Code (CRC) Section R314.1, CRC R315.2 states in part that existing dwellings be "...retrofitted with smoke and carbon monoxide alarms when a building permit is issued for, worked on or in a building that is valued at **\$1,000** or more." CRC Section R314.3, CRC R315.3 defines required locations as indicated above.

NOTE: This Certification is only used when normal access to the interior of the dwelling by the City of Downey Inspector is not achieved during the course of project construction. It is normally used for projects such as reroofs, patio covers, swimming pools, block walls, flatwork, and the like.
