**ORDER RESCINDING EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 3
WHICH AUTHORIZED THE CLOSURE OF DOWNEY AVENUE BETWEEN 2nd
and 3rd STREETS FOR TEMPORARY OUTDOOR BUSINESS USE
IN THE CITY OF DOWNEY**

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on July 23, 2020, the Emergency Services Director issued Emergency Order No. 3, which was ratified by the City Council on July 28, 2020, to allow businesses located on Downey Avenue between 2nd and 3rd Streets to utilize the public rights-of-way, sidewalks, parking spaces and the closed portion of Downey Avenue between 2nd and 3rd Streets to operate outdoors in compliance with the orders of the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health; and


WHEREAS, on September 22, 2020, the City Council directed that Downey Avenue between 2nd and 3rd Streets be reopened to vehicular traffic and that parklets be established to allow for outdoor operations of businesses on Downey Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, as the Director of Emergency Services pursuant to Downey Municipal Code Section 2433(a) and by the powers vested in me by Downey Municipal Code Section 2434, I hereby RESCIND Emergency Order No. 3 effective immediately and declare the closure of Downey Avenue between 2nd and 3rd Streets to be no longer in effect, subject to the following:


1. Businesses operating outdoors on Downey Avenue between 2nd and 3rd Streets shall have twenty one (21) days from the day of this Order to move their operations to allow for the reopening of Downey Avenue to vehicular traffic and to comply with any other requirements established by the City.
