NOTICE OF A PUBLIC HEARING FOR A  
ADOPTION OF AN INTERIM ORDINANCE**

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held before the DOWNEY CITY COUNCIL on the 12th day of May 2026, at 6:30 p.m., in the Council Chambers within Downey City Hall, 11111 Brookshire Avenue, Downey, California. At that time and place, consideration will be given to the following:

The City Council of the City of Downey will consider the adoption of an extension of an Urgency Ordinance for a period of one (1) year, continuing a moratorium on the approval, commencement, establishment, relocation, or expansion of a single price/overstock discount store (SPODS) within the City of Downey. The City previously adopted an urgency ordinance No. 25-1528 on May 28, 2025, to establish a 45-day moratorium on (SPODS) within City limits and subsequently adopted Ordinance No. 2025-1529, on July 8, 2025, extending the moratorium, which is set to expire on May 27, 2026, unless extended by the City Council.

All interested parties are invited to submit written comments and/or to attend and give testimony. The agenda and staff report, which provides a detailed description and analysis of this project, will be posted to the City Boards and Commission Meetings page of the City's website (<http://www.downeyca.org>) on the Friday prior to the public hearing.

Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), this request has been found not to be subject to CEQA, per Section 15061(b)(3) of the CEQA Guidelines because it will not have a significant effect on the environment, as the Ordinance will temporarily preclude the approval, commencement, establishment, relocation, or expansion of certain land uses City-wide.
