A regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the Southeast Water Coalition Joint Powers Authority was held on Thursday, April 2, 2026 at 7:00 p.m. at the Norwalk Arts & Sports Complex, Sproul Room, 13000 Clarkdale Avenue, Norwalk CA 90650. Chair Ana Valencia called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. At the time the meeting was called to order, a quorum of members was present.

ITEM 2 – PUBLIC COMMENT

Director Valencia introduced Ms. DeWitt from WRD, who provided history on the relationship between WRD and SEWC and previous letters sent between the two entities. She noted that she wants to work together amicably and that WRD recently helped support a City member of SEWC.

There were no further comments.

ITEM 3 - CONSENT CALENDAR

Director Rogers moved to approve the consent calendar.

ITEM 4 - PRESENTATION BY THE ASSOCIATION OF CALIFORNIA WATER AGENCIES (ACWA)

Ms. Koontz introduced ACWA presenter Mr. Michael Cervantes, who joined virtually to outline ACWA membership and available resources. He reviewed ACWA's structure, including the executive committee, ten regions, and the active role of regional boards. He noted that SEWC cities are part of Region 8, covering the Los Angeles area, and encouraged participation in regional events and other opportunities offered throughout the year.

Mr. Cervantes highlighted ACWA's 13 standing committees, government relations work, and extensive advocacy efforts. He explained that ACWA tracks hundreds of bills for members, that State Legislative Committee meetings are open for listening, and that a monthly regulatory update email is available for those who join the distribution list.

He also summarized ACWA's major events, including regional gatherings, two annual conferences, workshops, webinars, a legislative symposium, and the February Washington, D.C. conference. He emphasized the strong networking opportunities at the spring conference in Sacramento and the fall conference in Anaheim, along with member pricing for all events.

Mr. Cervantes concluded by outlining ACWA's communications tools that members can access online or receive directly by email. He also noted that ACWA offers several award programs recognizing member agencies and their work.

ITEM 5 - DISCUSSION/ACTION REGARDING A POLICY FOR ADMINISTRATIVE ENTITY LETTERS

Ms. Koontz stated that this item was brought forward because in November AE meeting, there was a discussion regarding the need for the AE to write and send letters on behalf of SEWC when deadlines do not allow sufficient time for prior approval at Board Meetings.

She noted that the issue arose specifically as a result of concerns surrounding state proposed public health goals for contaminants in drinking water and associated deadlines for public comment. She then presented the policy and standardized template that the AE put together for the Board's consideration and approval.

Director Zamora moved to approve the following:

- a) Review and approve the draft policy and letter template that would allow the Administrative Entity to collectively send correspondence without Board approval, if necessary.

ITEM 6 – DISCUSSION/ACTION REGARDING UPDATE TO THE WATER REPLENISHMENT DISTRICT'S REQUEST TO JOIN THE SOUTHEAST WATER COALITION

Ms. Koontz provided context around the original letter from WRD and the consensus among the AE members that WRD's application should be discussed further. To help provide clarity and to develop a recommendation to the Board, an ad-hoc committee was formed.

The original plan was that once the subcommittee completed its review, they would provide an update to the AE at their March meeting followed by a recommendation from the AE to the Board in April.

However, this most recent letter from WRD, dated February 23, 2026, rescinded their request to join, so no review was necessary. The letter was included in the Agenda Packet as reference.

There were no further questions or comments.

ITEM 7 – GENERAL LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

Ms. Koontz introduced Mr. Ghirelli, who provided an update on SB-1313, the bill proposing the creation of a fund within the State Water Board. He explained that although the bill previously passed both houses without issue, it was ultimately vetoed by the Governor due to the absence of dedicated funding. The bill has since been reintroduced, and Mr. Ghirelli will continue to keep SEWC informed as it moves forward. He also noted that ACWA will be sharing significant updates on related legislative activity.

In response to a question from Director Valencia regarding whether the bill had changed, Mr. Ghirelli confirmed that revisions have been made, particularly related to penalty structures and PFAS remediation.

ITEM 8 – BOARD OF DIRECTORS COMMENTS

Director Zamora invited SEWC members to his city's Arts Fest on April 25th at 2:00 PM, noting that there will be a lot of artists from surrounding cities.

Director Rogers wished members the best of luck with upcoming elections.

ITEM 9 – ADMINISTRATIVE ENTITY CHAIR/LEAD AGENCY COMMENTS

Ms. Koontz reported on two items. She shared that Norwalk staff has mailed out membership packets, and that Lynwood requested and received informational materials as well, though they have not yet submitted an official application.

She also noted that WRD had been asked to present their budget. WRD indicated they were unable to do so at this meeting but confirmed they will provide the presentation at the next meeting.

ITEM 8 - ADJOURNMENT

The meeting adjourned at 7:38 p.m.

**Subject: DISCUSSON/ACTION REGARDING SEWC FY 2026-27 BUDGET
APPROVAL**

Discussion:

The Proposed Budget for Fiscal Year (FY) 2026-27 includes the Approved Budget for FY 2025-26, Total Projected Expenditures for FY 2025-26, and a Proposed Budget for FY 2026-27. The Ending Balance for the FY 2025-26 stands at approximately \$166,929.47, reflecting both actual expenditures and projections for the remainder of the ongoing fiscal year. This is higher than the Approved Budget's Ending Balance of \$123,759.47 due to projected expenditures versus revenue intake. The ending balances every FY will likely continue to be less than the approved FY budget until dues are adjusted.

Anticipated member agency dues for FY 2026-27 remain at \$60,500, inclusive of credits to member agencies. There was no change to the member rates from last year. With total expenditures projected to increase during the FY 2026-27, the Proposed Budget indicates an Ending Balance of \$112,429.47.

During the May AE meeting, there was discussion about the budget and whether the Lead Agency should be compensated for staff time. AE members agreed that, rather than providing direct reimbursement, it would be more appropriate to exempt the Lead Agency from paying SEWC dues during the years in which they serve in that role. The budget reflects this update.

Recommendation: Approve and adopt the FY 2026/2027 Budget, as presented.

Subject: DISCUSSION/ACTION REGARDING SOUTHEAST WATER COALITION WEBSITE

Discussion:

During the March and May Administrative (AE) Meetings, the option of procuring a standalone Southeast Water Coalition (SEWC) website was raised. The purpose of this website would be to host all SEWC related information, agenda packets, and activities in one place. Additionally, it would support historical information by hosting everything on one website, rather than being on multiple websites based on which city was the lead agency at the time. SEWC Staff met with two recommended website designers, Streamline and Revize and attached are the respective proposals.

Revize provided follow-up information by email, noting that the company has more than 25 years of experience building website solutions and is well-versed in Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessibility requirements. Including new ADA Title II mandates. Revize highlighted that even a basic website must account for full ADA compliance, including agendas, uploaded PDFs and documents, and the website platform itself. Their proposal includes all required compliance features, with additional details provided in the attached materials.

Revize also shared that their proposal includes comprehensive support, licensing, and a wide range of built-in features, with pricing outlined on page 16. They noted that they have ensured no increases to the annual fee and have applied a 50% discount to the project cost, reducing it to \$1,500. They reiterated that many features, including the RZ ADA Widget Tool Tier 1, are included at no extra cost, and they provided a document listing all included features.

Recommendation: Review and approve a preferred proposal for a Southeast Water Coalition website.
